Concept Note

Over the last three years, BX ARABIA grew into a truly global event, but kept a tradition of focusing on regional and development issues as well as bringing prominent behavioural scientists especially from the Global South.

Indeed, this is what makes the BX Arabia series special, namely, the mix of academics and practitioners it brings together, as well as the richness of intellectual capital and debates it makes available regarding applications of behavioural insights to a variety of public health challenges including in areas of health, environment, labour, compliance, inclusion, violent extremism, along with lessons learned of, not only what worked, but also what did not.

Another key feature of BX ARABIA is that it served, and continues to serve, as a platform for collaborations and partnerships between government, non-profits, academia, and the private sector across a wide range of public policy areas.

This year, BX Arabia 2021 will take place on November 9th, at the time the world is rising from the setback of the global pandemic and will continue its collaborative tradition through a hybrid model. We are bringing experts to Doha, Qatar for panel discussions around teaching of behavioural insights to policy practitioners and beyond, how behavioural insights can be used to engage youth for social impact, and using behavioural insights to tackle vaccine hesitancy. We are also organizing a round table that will bring together representatives from behavioural insights units from the Global South to discuss, in particular, region-specific policy challenges. The live event will also include an online session organized by **WHO** on the use of behavioural data and evidence to guide national COVID-19 policy. In addition, there will be this year one-on-one interviews and special podcasts with keynote speakers organized by **Behavioral Grooves: Tim Houlihan** and **Kurt Nelson**.
